



What to do if you are worried your child is being bullied or could be showing bullying behaviour towards others

Listen to your child and reassure them that they have done the right thing in talking to you.

Speak to the class teacher as soon as you can. You can do this in person if you are able to get to school or by contacting the school office on 01455 290511 or office@barlestone.leics.sch.uk. You may need to make an appointment but this will always be organised as soon as possible.

The class teacher will listen to your concerns and then may need a short time to investigate and speak to your child in more detail. They will then arrange another meeting with you to discuss what the best way to move forward.

Read through the school behaviour policy, the anti bullying policy and share the child friendly anti-bullying policy with your child. These can all be found on the website either in the same section as this advice or in the policies section.

Continue to reassure your child that everyone is working together to make sure that they feel happy and confident in school.

Keep in touch with school if you have any further concerns.
