MATHS

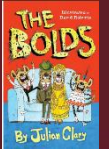


In maths this term we are learning about money, multiplication and division, measurement and fractions.

Within multiplication we will begin looking at the 2, 5 and 10 times tables.

READING

In reading this term we are using lots of different extracts to explore genres. We have already begun to look at New Year traditions. We will then be looking at a series of books called The Bolds and then moving on to some Bunny vs Monkey books.



WRITING

In writing this term we have read *The Day the Crayons Quit*. We will be writing a letter from a Crayon to Duncan. To do this we will be learning how to use subordination, apostrophes and writing in the correct tense.



WIDER CURRICULUM

History- We are looking at different Explorers across History.

Art- We will be creating our very own self-portraits.

Geography- We will be looking at continents.

Science- We will be doing experiments with everyday materials.

THINGS TO REMEMBER....

PE Kits - PE is on a Monday and Thursday. We will continue to send PE kits home on a Thursday.

Homework - Spellings will be tested on a Friday. Reading books will be checked on a Wednesday.

Changing reading books – After reading their whole book a child may take a test on an iPad. If they score 60% or above they can change their book. If they score below 60% we ask that they read their book again. Year 2 have access to iPads every Friday afternoon (tests may be available on other days but this cannot be guaranteed).
