MATHS

In maths this term we will be focusing on Perimeter and Length. Looking at different units of measurement and how to calculate perimeter of different shapes.

This term there will also be a big focus on our times tables, from 2x to 12x, getting ready for the MTC in Summer term.

READING

In reading this term we will look at a variety of texts such as articles, videos, stories, graphic novels and non-fiction. Touching on topics such as Chinese New Year, Sports and Children's mental health.

Within this we will use a variety of skills by retrieving, summarising, interpreting information and look at vocabulary within these texts.

WRITING

In writing this term we are building up to write a persuasive letter for road safety outside of schools and how this could be improved.

We will look at linking adverbs and how to structure paragraphs using topic sentences, supporting details and concluding sentences.

WIDER CURRICULUM

In the wider curriculum this term we are looking at a range of topics:

History – The Roman Empire

Science – Electricity

Geography – The Americas
